All suitable videos will be on display for viewing on the website, and 20 videos selected by our youth co-chairs will be showcased in a conference presentation during the virtual congress held online from August 1st to August 5th, 2021.

This global opportunity is open to students who can enter as an individual or in small groups. This is a perfect opportunity for your ideas to be shared on a global stage! School students should be 10 years or older, however videos from younger students may be considered.

The videos must be original or innovative, must not use copyrighted music, and must be in English or have English subtitles. Your video can be a slide presentation, cartoon, video, or a talk.

Some topics for your ideas could be:

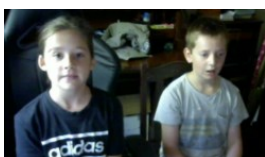


If you are intending to enter then please register your interest with a 200 word description in English in an email. Your parents and/or teachers will be have to register you on a form, which will be sent to you when we receive your register of interest. Your entry is dependent on your agreement that your video becomes the property of WAC, for display purposes only. We also need permission from every person who appears in the video.

Deadline for registration is midnight July 1st, and videos must be submitted by midnight, July 21st Sydney Australia time. Video presenters will receive free access to the WAC Reboot 2021 video session, and will receive a participation certificate.
